These 'Gigi' chairs from Vincent Sheppard are made from specially treated stainless steel, with a woven seat that has been fully weatherproofed with outdoor paint and latex. The chairs measure 82 x 62 x 57cm and cost £370 each. They are available in snow (seen here), broken white, beige, taupe or quartz grey. *Vincent Sheppard* (tel: 00-32-56 46 1114; www.vincentshppard.com)

This 'TR220' chaise is part of the Trestle collection designed for Summit Furniture by Kipp Stewart. Made from plantation teak, it comes with a cushion covered in acrylic fabric which has been solution dyed (the fibres are coloured while in liquid state), so is resistant to fading, rot and mildew. The elegant 'Bowline' lounger by Gaze Burvill has a marine-grade stainless-steel frame with a removable and washable Sunbrella seat, which is available in four colours: coal (seen here), navy blue, forest green and canvas. Measuring 120 x 206 x 72cm, the lounger has five reclining positions and comes with an adjustable and removable head cushion. The 'Norsebury' table from The Heveningham Collection has a 150cm diameter Cabucca limestone top that can be left outside all year round. The base is made from mild steel, shown here in a black finish, with a hot-zinc and powder coating, which protects it from rusting and makes it fully weatherproof.
